Producing godly African leaders...

In 2002 I had the opportunity to bring 25 university students to Capetown, South Africa to do evangelism on the campus of University of Western Cape. In 13 days the Lord blessed us to see 200 students reached with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Since then, there's been a spiritual

movement on that campus. As a result of that experience the Lord placed a desire in my heart to return someday and trust him to raise up the next generation of godly African leaders through the transformational power of Jesus Christ. Little did I know God had in mind to give me an opportunity to serve as *Student Led Movement* Director, which involves mobilizing campus staff to reach all the campuses in South Africa.

To launch spiritual movements...

As the campus teams and I serve on the various campuses in South Africa, it's my desire that we become as relevant and effective as possible with the gospel. Some of the challenges we face are other religions, apathy, religiosity and agnosticism. As South Africa becomes more secular in its culture, there's a growing need to think more creatively and innovatively as we present the gospel to others. But the gospel is making an impact on the

lives of others. Here's one student's experience of witnessing captured by a campus staff member. *"One of our students had gone to reach out regularly. At one stage he shared with a guy and this guy prayed to receive Christ. A few weeks later he shared with another guy and he also prayed to receive Christ. Later it came out that these two guys are twins. Both prayed to receive Christ on separate occasions with the same CCC student sharing with them. What's the chance of that happening on a campus with about 40,000 students? God's great!!!!" God is still speaking in a "today's generation" voice.*

To the Nations.

South Africa is one of 23 countries in the southern and eastern Africa region with Campus Crusade. As we begin to see more and more students get involved in our ministries we desire to expose and send them to other nations in this region and around the world. Dr. Delanyo Adadevoh, Vice President of International Ministries with Campus Crusade for Christ says, *"Africa's concern should*

be the pursuit of righteousness. When Africa is righteous before God, she will live and develop in a holistic and God-honoring way." My desire is that as we raise up godly leaders from our campus ministries in South Africa, they will go to other nations and do the same. However, we don't necessarily need to travel outside our borders to do so. Many people from various other nations live right here. During that horrible season of "xenophobia" many people were attacked and some even killed because black South Africans didn't feel they should be taking the few jobs that exist here. And yet, it's an incredible opportunity to be Jesus' hands, feet and voice in these kinds of situations. One student, Chris from Cameroon stated, *"I was scared. All I wanted to do was go home. They would attack me when I was traveling on the train."* Praise God, Chris experienced the love of God while being involved in one of our bible studies on campus.
