Most respond with any percentage less than one hundred if they do so at all. Asking this question **always** engages me and others in a spiritual conversation that leads us to sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. It is with this question that many are trained in how to go door-to-door witnessing as they seek to be committed and obedient followers of Jesus Christ.

## To do God's work!

Like many of the leaders I'm training and developing, I'm responsible to have a personal ministry. This has involved training and equipping others in my church to do evangelism and discipleship, speaking and preaching in various churches to serving with Hope of Glory Ministries, which involves meeting the physical and spiritual needs of orphans in the Hammanskraal area.

Hope of Glory Ministries started in 2009 with a desire on the part of several ladies in one of my bible studies burdened to do something about the growing population of orphans in South Africa. We launched this effort towards our orphans by bringing Christmas to them in December 2009. Not only has this become something that we do annually but have expanded to being registered with the Department of Social Development. For every event that we have with the kids, grannies and aunties we seek to share the good news of Jesus Christ. Our future desire is to expand to other sites while being the hands, feet and voice of Jesus. Hope of Glory Ministries allows us to engage more directly in addressing some of South Africa's poverty and unemployment issues. Through this ministry we will be developing a "Drop In Center" whereby children can come, get a healthy meal and be tutored to improve their school grades. Our "Life Skills Center" will allow us to equip teens and adults with the key skills needed to engage more effectively in their community and beyond!
